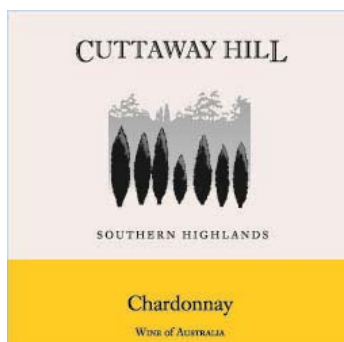


Cuttaway Hill Estate



2010 Chardonnay

Cuttaway Hill Estate is cradled in the mountains of the Southern Highlands in NSW, at 700m above sea level with all grapes being grown and harvested on the family owned estate.

The Seven Daughters range of Cuttaway wines is represented by our logo - a typical Southern Highlands scene. The wines are selected each vintage to offer wine lovers a true taste of the Southern Highlands in a glass.

- Harvested:** 4 April 2010
- Region:** Southern Highlands 100%
- Varieties:** Chardonnay 100%
- Vineyard:** Cuttaway
- Vintage:** A slow cool vintage with steady even ripening, during veraison resulting in wines of intense varietal character and cool climate delicacy, balance and longevity.
- Analysis:** Alcohol 13.0%
Standard drinks 7.6
pH 3.4
TA 6.1g/L
RS 2.1 g/L
Preservatives 220
- Winemaking:** Primary fermentation in stainless steel at a cool 11-16°C for approx 10days. Approx 25% of the wine is aged for six months in selected French oak. The remaining wine is un-oaked and undergoes no malolactic fermentation to enhance its fine natural acids and strong primary fruit characters.
- Seal:** Screwcap
- Appearance:** Light straw with a vibrant green tint
- Bouquet:** Citrus and white peach with just a hint of oak
- Palate:** Fresh stonefruit and citrus characters with a complex and balanced finish
- Cellaring:** Best drinking now to 2018
- Serve with:** Freshly cooked pacific king prawns with a lime and dill mayonnaise dressing
