Laurence Sparkling Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot

Cuttaway Hill Estate is cradled in the mountains of the Southern Highlands in NSW, at 700m above sea level with all grapes being grown and harvested on the family owned estate.

The Laurence range of sparkling wines from Cuttaway Hill wines are named in honour of the founder of Cuttaway Hill, Laurence O'Neil. They are made in a traditional single bottle fermentation method and aged on lees before disgorgement and release.

Region:	Southern Highlands 100%
Varieties:	Cabernet Sauvignon 65% Merlot 35%
Vineyard:	Cuttaway
Style:	An exceptionally brilliant Cuvée Brut style with low yields producing a mature full flavoured sparkling wine with fine balance and exceptional length.
Analysis:	Alcohol 12.5% Preservatives 220 + 300
Base Winemaking:	The base wines undergo a cool primary fermentation in stainless steel on skins for 7 days followed by full malolactic fermentation in selected medium toast French and American hogsheads. Secondary fermentation in a single bottle with extended time on lees in the Cuttaway Hill cellars prior to dosage and release.
Seal:	Diam cork
Appearance:	Ruby red
Bouquet:	Ripe blackberry and red currant with savoury and earthy notes
Palate:	A fine mousse with sweet berry and savoury characters coupled with a long lively finish
Serve with:	Serve cold as an aperitif or with game dishes
