Laurence Sparkling Chardonnay Pinot Noir

Cuttaway Hill Estate is cradled in the mountains of the Southern Highlands in NSW, at 700m above sea level with all grapes being grown and harvested on the family owned estate.

The Laurence range of sparkling wines from Cuttaway Hill wines are named in honour of the founder of Cuttaway Hill, Laurence O'Neil. They are made in a traditional single bottle fermentation method and aged on lees in Cuttaway Hill cellars before disgorgement and release.

Region:	Southern Highlands 100%
Varieties:	Chardonnay 52% Pinot Noir 48%
Vineyard:	Cuttaway Hill
Style:	An exceptionally brilliant Cuvée Prestige Brut style with low yields producing mature full flavoured sparkling wine with fine balance and exceptional length.
Analysis:	Alcohol 12.0% Preservatives 220 + 300
Base Winemaking:	A premium single vineyard blend from hand harvested grapes followed by a slow cool primary fermentation only, for the base wine. Extended time on lees in the Cuttaway hill cellars prior to dosage and bottling.
Seal:	Diam cork
Appearance:	Light Straw
Bouquet:	Bread and yeast aromas with a hint toast
Palate:	A dry elegant palate of mature fruit with stunning length and a fine mousse, dominated by cool climate chardonnay characters
Serve with:	Natural oysters or light canapés
